

ITS Airsoft / Paintball Field Rules.

revision1 - 2011 / 2012

1. Rules **MUST** be followed at all times by all players participating in any and all ITS Sports events at the Skirmishes and or at the Hanford Field.
Failure to comply with the rules will *always* result in a verbal reminders or warning, and *may* result in expulsion from the event(s).
2. In extreme cases, ITS reserves the right to ban players from returning to all future events without any refund (if given) or recourse from the member/guest.
3. Additional rules may be present when playing at non ITS Airsoft events or Fields.
4. Chain of command is utilized for structure and event /site coordination and is as follows: General, Colonel, Captain, Sergeant, Soldier.
Assistants to the General are classified as Colonel's and assist in overall operations. Captains are Team and Skirmish Leaders. Sergeants are assistants to Captains. All levels of leadership will also be available to assist in event rules, equipment and general coordination of events and site.
Leadership is here to serve, not to be served. Keep that in mind of your desiring "position". You're here earlier, and leave later usually. :)
5. Site General has final say along with his established chain of command.
6. All club members must complete & sign a waiver prior to participation in any events.
7. Walk-ons must complete a waiver for each event if one is not on file for them.
Anyone under 18 years of age must have a signed waiver by a legal parent/guardian.
8. All event participants must wear ANSI Z87+ manufactured level goggles and or mask. **Mesh-Masks** are **not** allowed.
9. ITS Team Members must participate at least twice annually in one of the offered 'Safety Days' and is a requirement for leadership. - Walk-ons will be subject to a pre-event safety overview.
10. ITS Team Members must try and make field clean up and work party days.
11. **SPORTSMAN-LIKE** conduct must be followed at all times
12. Shooting and practicing must be in designated area(s), no random shooting in parking or staging areas please!
13. FPS limits are as follows: 420 fps with .20 gram bb - full auto weapons 520 fps with .20 gram bb - single shot weapons - 100ft minimum engagement distance
14. All participants must subject their weapons to chronographing prior to each event
15. No knives, lighters, pyrotechnics, explosives, real firearms, or any other hazardous items, objects, or materials are allowed on the field at any time.
16. Alcohol is not permitted at any events, anyone who is known to be intoxicated will not be allowed to participate.

17. Language is strongly encouraged to apply a “PG” rating. Please keep “mild” profanity to a minimum. (if needed at all) No extreme profanity allowed. We try and keep a family fun atmosphere and in doing so, we are respectful to our younger guests. Most parents and adults appreciate this. In the case of mild profanity, we will remind you in a respectful way, understanding some times verbal slips happen and in the heat of things. Heavy profanity will receive warning.
18. Any and all event photographers must wear bright red or orange clothing along with regular safety equipment.
19. Weather appropriate clothing must be worn to all events. No swim suits or inappropriate clothing please.
